RESEARCH ACTIVITIES

Multi-disciplinary Research Unit



The VPCI-DHR-ICMR-Multi-disciplinary Research Unit (MRU) is a part of the Government of India approved initiative for establishment of multidisciplinary research units in Government medical colleges/research institutions during the 12th plan period. Under this scheme, financial assistance of upto 5.25 crores is being provided to VPCI.

The VPCI-DHR-ICMR-MRU aims to (1) undertake research in non-communicable diseases and other need based research employing newer tools, (2) promote and encourage quality multi-disciplinary medical research in the Institution, (3) improve the overall health status of the population by creating evidence based application of diagnostic procedures/processes/methods.

Prof. S.K. Bansal was appointed as the Nodal Officer of the VPCI-DHR-ICMR-MRU since May 2017. Two research proposals on lung cancer and lung fibrosis are presently ongoing. Dr. V. Rohil, Department of Biochemistry (Clinical Biochemistry), is assessing the role of Ellagic acid and its derivative, peracetate, in epigenetic regulations leading to apoptosis in lung cancer. Dr. Ritu Kulshrestha, Department of Pathology, is working on extracellular matrix remodelling, matrix metalloproteinase expression and their targeting by nanoparticle mediated drug delivery for ameliorating pulmonary fibrosis. The work is being carried out with active participation of the MRU Research Scientists, Dr. Kakuli Purkayastha and Dr. Jyoti Batra.

Extramural Research Projects

Presently, 16 extramurally research projects (funded by ICMR, DBT, INSA, DST, DST-FIST, AYUSH, WHO,

CCRUM, APACI, AAYUSH / CCRAS, UGC-BSR) and 2 VPCI-DHR-ICMR Multi-disciplinary Research Unit (MRU) funded research projects are ongoing in the Institute. In addition, two new extramurally funded research projects & one Research Fellowship was additionally sanctioned during the period.

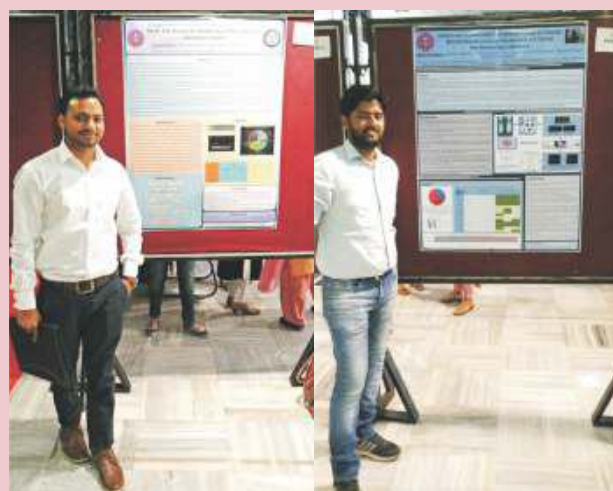

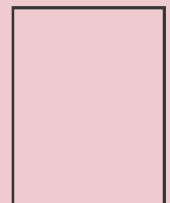
