V.P. Chest Institute is a pioneer Post Graduate Medical Teaching and Research Institute funded by the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Govt. of India and maintained by the University of Delhi. The Institute is looking for dynamic and result-oriented persons for the following posts:

- 1. Deputy Registrar (Rs. 12000-420-18300) (UR)**  
Master's degree with at least 55% marks or its equivalent grade of B in the UGC seven point scale with administrative experience as Assistant Registrar or in an equivalent post or above for five years.  
*Desirable:* Candidate with Degree in Law
- 2. Senior Technical Assistant (Stores) (Rs. 5500-175-9000) (OBC)**  
Graduate in Science with minimum 50% marks and six years experience in store management as Technical Assistant in the grade of Rs.4500-125-7000 or above preferably in Medical Institutions.  
*Desirable:* Diploma in material management.
- 3. Senior Technical Assistant (Refrigeration) (Rs. 5500-175-9000) (OBC)**  
Diploma in Mechanical Engineering with three years practical experience OR ITI Certificate (2 years course) in refrigeration with nine years practical experience.  
Assistance in experimental work is essential. The applicants should have experience in handling scientific equipment, maintenance of controlled temperature apparatus, servicing and maintenance of laboratory and industrial refrigeration and air-conditioning equipments/plants.
- 4. Senior Technical Assistant (Rs. 5500-175-9000) (UR-1, OBC-1, SC-1) in the departments of Cardio-respiratory Physiology (UR), Pharmacology (OBC) and Respiratory Allergy & Applied Immunology (SC)**  
Graduate in Science with minimum 50% marks and six years experience in respective areas as Technical Assistant in the grade of Rs.4500-125-7000 or above preferably in Medical Institutions.
- 5. Nursing Sister (Rs. 5500-175-9000) (UR)**  
*Essential qualification & experience:* B.Sc.(Nursing) from a recognized University/Institute with minimum 50% of marks and registered as Nurse with Nursing Council of any State in India with 6 years experience as Staff Nurse in a tertiary care teaching hospital (or) Matric or equivalent qualification with Diploma in Nursing & Midwifery from a recognized University/Institute and registered as Nurse with Nursing Council of any state in India with 8 years experience as Staff Nurse in a tertiary care teaching hospital.  
*Desirable:* Experience in Pulmonary and Critical Care Medical Wards.
- 6. Technical Assistant (Rs. 4500-125-7000) (SC-4, ST-1) in the departments of Clinical Biochemistry (SC), Microbiology (SC-2), Respiratory Allergy & Applied Immunology (SC) and Respiratory Virology (ST)**  
Graduate in Science with minimum 50% marks and six years experience in respective areas as Laboratory Assistant in the grade of Rs.4000-100-6000 or above preferably in Medical Institutions.
- 7. Laboratory Assistant (Rs. 4000-100-6000) (UR) in Pharmacology**  
Matric with Science and six years experience in respective area as a Laboratory Attendant in the grade of Rs.2650-65-3300-70-4000 or above preferably in Medical Institutions.

- 8. Junior Assistant (Rs. 3050-75-3950-80-4590) (UR-1, OBC-4)**  
Senior Secondary (10+2)  
Eligible candidates will be required to appear in a Preliminary Test which will consist of General Intelligence, Awareness, and English & Numerical Ability. Those who qualify in the Preliminary Tests will be required to appear in the Aptitude Test in English typing @ 30 wpm alongwith a written test in English).
- 9. Junior Library & Information Assistant (Rs. 3050-75-3950-80-4590) (UR)**
  1. Passed Sr. Secondary or equivalent examination conducted by State Board of Education/University/Govt. recognized institutions.
  2. Certificate in Library Science/Library and Information Science from a recognized institution.
  3. Computer Course at Sr. Secondary Level or Basic Course in Computer Science/Word Processing from a recognized Institution.
- 10. Laboratory Attendant (Rs. 2650-65-3300-70-4000) (UR-2, OBC-4, ST-1)**  
*Essential:* Matric with Science.  
*Desirable:* Should have worked in a recognized laboratory related to medical sciences for one year.

**Note:**

- a. Those interested should apply on prescribed application form for the post obtainable from the office of the Assistant Registrar (Admn.II), VP Chest Institute, University of Delhi, P.O. Box No. 2101, Delhi-110 007 against a written request along with a non-refundable fee of Rs.100/- in the form of Nationalized Bank Demand Draft payable at Delhi & drawn in favour of 'Director, VPCI', (Rs.50/- in case of SC/ST candidates) in person on working days between 10:00 AM to 1:00 PM or by post along with a self-addressed envelope bearing stamps of Rs.32/-. - b. The last dates for issue of application form and submission thereof duly completed to the Assistant Registrar (Admn.II) are 20 days and 30 days respectively from the date of publication.
- c. Reservation and relaxation for SC/ST/OBC/Physically Challenged candidates exist as per rules.
- d. Separate application is required for each post and department.
- e. The posts carry DA, HRA, TA etc. as admissible under the rules of University/Institute.
- f. The Institute reserves the right not to fill up all or any of the vacancies advertised if the circumstances so warrant.
- g. Relaxation in qualification may be made in exceptional cases on the recommendations of the Selection Committee.
- h. Those who submit downloaded application form website or copy thereof are required to enclose Rs. 100/- (Rs.50/- in the case of SC/ST) alongwith their application in the mode as prescribed at Sri.No. (a) above.
- i. In the event of selection of internal candidates from the feeder cadre, the appointment shall be treated as promotion.
- j. The Institute reserves the right to down grade the post/scale of pay in the event candidate not found suitable to the advertised post.
