General information against advertisement for the TEACHING posts of Professor/Associate Professor/Assistant Professor

1. In the Departments of Physiology, Biochemistry and Microbiology non-medical teacher may be appointed to the extent of 30% of the total number of posts in the department. However, in the department of Biochemistry, non-medical teachers may be appointed to the extent of 50% of the total number of posts in the department. Non-medical teachers in the above subjects should possess approved Post Graduate qualifications in the subject and also hold a doctorate in the subject of speciality concerned. The Head of the Departments must possess a recognized basic university medical qualification or equivalent qualification.
2. All medical teachers must possess a basic university degree or equivalent qualification included in the schedule to the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956 as amended from time to time. They should also be registered under the State/Central Medical Registration Act. Postgraduate medical qualification should also find a place in the schedule of the Indian Medical Council (IMC) Act, 1956 as amended from time to time.
3. The qualifications and experience prescribed above are the minimum and mere possession of the same does not entitle any candidate to be called for interview. Where the number of applications received in response to this advertisement is large, it will not be convenient nor possible for the Institute to interview all those candidates; in that case the Institute may restrict the number of candidate for interview etc. to a reasonable limit on the basis of qualification and experience higher than the minimum prescribed in the advertisement.
4. Age limit for the direct appointment:
 - Assistant Professor: Not exceeding forty years (Relaxable for Government servants up to five years in accordance with the instructions issued by the Government of India).
 - Associate Professor/Professor: Not exceeding fifty years (Relaxable for Government servants up to five years in accordance with the instructions issued by the Government of India).
5. Teaching Experience required for direct recruitment:
 - Assistant Professor: In addition to the requirement of three years teaching experience as Senior Resident or Tutor or Demonstrator or Registrar in the concerned speciality in a recognized teaching institution after obtaining the Postgraduate degree, the following additional teaching/research experience in the concerned subject in a recognized medical college after obtaining DNB qualification shall be required:
 - a. For the candidates possessing DNB qualification from MCI recognized Medical Colleges/Central institutes where there are MD/MS courses running:
 - *No additional teaching/research experience required.*
 - b. For the candidates possessing DNB qualification from MCI recognized Medical Colleges/Central institutes where there are no MD/MS courses running:
 - *One year of additional teaching/research experience required.*
 - c. For the candidates possessing DNB qualification from centres other than of MCI recognized Medical Colleges/Central institutes:
 - *Two years of additional teaching/research experience required.*
 - Associate Professor: If a DNB qualified candidates is working as Assistant Professor in a MCI recognized Medical College /Central Institute, he/she would require one more year of teaching/research experience for appointment as Associate Professor over and above the minimum time frame for MD/MS candidate.
 - Persons possessing DNB qualification on the basis of which they have already been appointed as Associate Professor/Professor in the concerned department, may be treated at par with MD/MS in the broad-speciality and DM/M.Ch. in the Super-Speciality without any further teaching/research experience.
6. Applicants who are in the employment of Government/Semi-government organization/Educational Institute or of any Government Undertaking must send their applications through proper channel; otherwise their applications would not be considered.

7. Applications in prescribed format only will be accepted.
8. Applications must be accompanied by self-attested photocopies of certificates and testimonials in support of age, qualifications and experience; otherwise applications shall be treated as incomplete and shall be rejected.
9. Candidates are advised to ensure that they fulfill the eligibility criteria as mentioned above in the advertisement before applying to the post.
10. Candidates should have fulfilled the minimum eligibility such as education, experience & research publications on the date of submission of application.
11. Teaching Experience in any other post like the post of General Duty Medical Officer or Medical Officer shall not be considered for eligibility purpose for recruitment to teaching posts.
12. Besides pay, DA, HRA, TA, NPA (to medically qualified candidates only), New Pension Scheme and medical benefits etc. are admissible as per rules of the Institute.
13. Outstation candidates called for interview will be paid IIInd Class to and fro train fare on production of ticket.
14. The last date for submission duly completed to the Joint Registrar, VPCI is 30 days from the date of advertisement. If 30th day falls on holiday, the next working day will be last date of submission.
15. No application shall be accepted after the deadline even if it is posted earlier. It is the candidate's responsibility to ensure that the application is received by the Institute before 4:00 p.m. on the last date of submission of applications either by person or by post. Plea of postal delay shall not be entertained.
16. No correspondence or personal enquiries shall be entertained by the Institute.
17. Private practice of any kind whatsoever shall not be allowed including any consultation and laboratory practice.
18. Duties may include imparting theoretical and practical instructions to post-graduate medical/non-medical students and conducting and guiding research work in the speciality and rendering patients care in the speciality and other duties as assigned from time to time by the HOD/Director.
