**Subject: Reg. URGENT support for X-ray screening and information sharing for the 100-Days TB Campaign.**

Dear All,

This is in reference to DO No.Z-19042/12/2022/NACO-M&E-Part(4) dated 05<sup>th</sup> December 2024 from worthy Joint Secretary, Ministry of Health and Family Welfare (MoHFW), Government of India and DO No. SSHFW1/1233-39 dated 06<sup>th</sup> December 2024 from the Office of the undersigned, to extend support to the '100-Days TB Campaign'.

It has come to the notice of the undersigned that vulnerable persons referred for X-ray are facing difficulties in the hospitals regarding the registration and X-ray procedure. Additionally, the hospitals are providing chest X-ray to large number of symptomatic patients in the routine OPD but are not sharing the data with National TB Elimination Programme district authorities. In this regard, it is hereby directed that:

1. All list of persons undergoing chest X-ray in the hospital to be shared with NTEP district authorities for enrolment in Ni-kshay portal
2. The radiology department shall be directed to record Name, Gender, Age, Address and Mobile Number in the facility register to help enrolment of persons in Ni-kshay portal.
3. A dedicated registration counter and special X-ray time slots shall be provided to persons referred for X-ray under 100-Days TB Campaign from Chest Clinics and peripheral health facilities in Delhi
4. The aggregate count of persons (under vulnerable category i.e. >60yrs, diabetics, BMI<18.5 kg/cu.m, smokers, alcoholics and those attending specialized OPDs such as NCD Clinics, Cancer OPD, Geriatric OPD and Dialysis Centres) visiting daily OPD shall be provided.

The scale and urgency of this campaign requires the active involvement and support of all hospitals (under Government of India, Government of NCT Delhi, NDMC, ESI Hospitals, Northern Railway and all hospitals in private sector) within the NCT Delhi, thereby accelerating progress toward the goal of TB elimination.

You are requested to consider the matter on PRIORITY and issue necessary directives to the concerned for immediate compliance.
