Candidate first has to done registration and payment of annual fees in FMSc site on the said link <https://www.fmsc.ac.in/admission-pg.htm> under online application.

The following documents are required for Physical/ Online Reporting (for uploading) for verification by the College authorities:

- i. Application form fill by the candidate with payment details.
- ii. Allotment Letter issued by MCC (**Essential document**)
- iii. Admit Card issued by NBE (**Essential document**)
- iv. Result/Rank Letter issued by NBE (**Essential document**)
- v. Mark Sheets of MBBS/BDS 1st, 2nd & 3rd Professional Examinations (**Essential document**).
- vi. MBBS/BDS Degree Certificate/Provisional Certificate (**Essential document**).
- vii. Internship Completion Certificate/Certificate from the Head of Institution or College that the candidate shall complete the Internship by 31st March, of the year of admission (**Essential document**).
- viii. Permanent / provisional Registration Certificate issued by MCI or DCI/State Medical or Dental Council. Provisional Registration Certificate is acceptable only in cases where candidate is undergoing internship and likely to complete the same on or before 31st March of the year of admission (**Essential document**).
- ix. High School/Higher Secondary Certificate/Birth Certificate as proof of date or birth (**Essential document**).
- x. Candidates allotted seat must carry one of the identification proofs

(ID Proof) to the allotted college at the time of admission (as mentioned in the information Bulletin published by the National Board of Examinations (NBE) for AIPGMEE/ AIPGDEE i.e. PAN Card, Driving License, Voter ID, Passport or Aadhar Card) (**Essential document**).

- xi. The Candidate should also bring/ upload the following certificates, if applicable (**Essential document**)
- a) SC/ST Certificate issued by the competent authority and should be in English or Hindi language. Sub caste should be clearly mentioned in the certificate.
 - b) OBC certificate issued by the competent authority. The sub-caste should tally with the Central List of OBC. The OBC candidates should not belong to Creamy Layer. The OBC certificate must be in the format as mentioned in the prospectus.
 - c) Disability Certificate issued from a duly constituted and authorized Medical Board for 21 Benchmark Disabilities as per the Rights of Persons with Disability Act, 2016. No other PwD certificate, issued by any other Authorities/ Hospital will be entertained.

NOTE:

- Candidates **without original certificates / documents shall not be allowed to take admission** in allotted Medical / Dental College.
- All admissions made online will be deemed **Provisional**, subject to **verification of documents** at the time of Physical Joining/Reporting and Medical Fitness at the college.
- Candidates who want to give willingness for Upgradation for Round-2 while retaining Round-1 seat, have to **‘Report physically’** at the allotted institute to confirm their admission.
- The candidates will be intimated to deposit the required fees online after verification of their submitted documents by the competent authority of the Institute.
- The candidates who join their seat of Round-1 and later want to resign the same can do so till **04:00 P.M of 3rd February, 2022 after which they will be considered as part of Round-2 and same rules will apply as applicable for Round- 2 of counselling.**
- Candidates who want to avail ‘Free Exit’ option in Round-1 need not Report at the allotted college.
