

GUIDELINES FOR PG EXAMINATION (MD/MS /DIPLOMA /MDS):

1. There shall be four examination centres i.e. MAMC, UCMS, LHMC and Army Hospital (R&R).
2. The Army Hospital R&R has been included as Independent Centre being recognized Examination Centre by the University of Delhi. Outside students will not be allowed to appear for exam at this centre. The students of this Institute shall appear for exam at this centre only.
3. The Theory paper Examinations will be held at all the centres simultaneously [on same date and time], and will use the same question papers sent by the Examination branch.
4. The papers will be printed and sent by the Examination branch to all 4 centres.
5. Time span for Theory Examinations:

From 16th June to 22nd June

Time span for Practical Examinations

From 24th to 29th June, 2020
6. The answer sheets may be permitted to be sent to the External Examiners who express the inability to be physically present[in view of the MCI guidelines dated 22nd May, 2020] about certain relaxations about Examinerships] for evaluation by External Examiners.

The responsibility to scan and transmit the same as encrypted mail to the external examiner who is unable to come shall rest with the Department in which exam is being conducted. If the department can not accomplish this , they may ensure the physical presence of external examiner at the centre in accordance with MCI guidelines.
7. The scanned answer sheets be sent as encrypted mail with End to End Encryption. In no case the Answersheet be allowed to go without being evaluated by the External Examiners.


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8. The Practical Examination will be allowed to be conducted at the above mentioned 4 centres separately but preferably on same dates.
9. Each Centre will be allowed to take up to eight examinees per day and the complete Examination in respect of these eight candidates will finish same day.
10. No examinee will be called on two different or subsequent days.
11. On line availability of the External Examiner [if required] be ensured as agreed upon by the Internal Examiner concerned. The mail IDs, name ,Phone number etc. should be ensured and communicated to the Faculty of Medical Sciences.
12. In no case less than two External Examiners be permitted in a centre .Wherever there is only one Internal Examiner available, three external Examiners should be taken with prior permission of MCI[two of them to be physically present and one available on line], and result then be declared only after approval from MCI.
13. Wherever[in the departments wherever the Inspection is due, the Inspection should be allowed to be deferred , with information to MCI.
14. No external examiner from Jamia Hamdard, which is not recognized for Post graduate Courses, be allowed to be invited.
15. The retired persons who retired upto five years back, but still working in a recognized Medical College may be allowed to be called as Examiner. No retired person who is not working in a Medical College currently may be allowed to be called, as External Examiner.
16. Those lacking MCI recognized postgraduate qualifications be allowed to be called as the External Examiners.
17. The External Examiners from the Private Medical Colleges preferably not allowed to be taken, except those retired as recognized Professor by the University within last 5 years, and currently working too, in a Medical College.


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18. Wherever, the Committee of Courses for a department, has been duly held in the current Academic year [to which the Postgraduate Examination belong] the University Head may permit the change of Examinership on behalf of the CCS, for subsequent approval by Dean , and in all other cases the CCS be held for this purpose, physically or online.
19. The responsibility to call the External Examiner will rest on College HOD/ Internal Examiner. The list of Reserve Internal examiners will be seen from the records, wherever the CCS has been duly held, as commented earlier.
20. The assessment sheets will be sent to all Institutions to ensure uniformity, by office of Faculty of Medical Sciences.
21. The Examination process will finish by 29th June, 2020 for compilation and declaration of results by 30th June, 2020. There is no provision for moderation in the MCI PGIMER [revised] and this may be noted by all Heads of Institutions and Heads of departments and Internal Examiners in the Institutions
22. The passes if required to allow movements for Exams in any case, will be issued by the Head of the Institution /department in college as were being done for essential services, on the production of the ticket issued , after completion of requirements by the Office of Faculty of Medical Sciences.
23. No financial Allocation will be permitted, beyond what is disbursed by Exam branch.
24. About the problems of department mentioned by departments concerned, the HODs concerned may contact the receiving department at UCMS and LHMC for their concurrence. Faculty and University may permit this as stand alone objection if receiving department is ready to accommodate. No precedence may be allowed to be made of this, by any other department and Institution. These two departments may clarify, if there is no candidate from associated institutions [which is not an Examination centre in itself].This requirement does not hold in case of the associated Institutions like Kasturba, Hindu Rao etc., which have


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to be associated with one other centre. DR [Medical] has been authorised to request University HOD Microbiology to accommodate the students of MD[Microbiology] of MAMC at UCMS examination centre.

- 25 Lastly, it is important to realize that departments would need more time to hold practicals than is generally appreciated because candidates' number is bigger now even upto 30 plus. Then there are candidates from other institutions plus failures of previous years, so we have to begin theory examination at earliest thus leaving enough days to hold practicals.
